This year marks the 7th year of the STOREhouse ministry at SPCC. It was started in November of 2011 by Ken & Emilee Parton, who felt led by God to begin an outreach to help feed & clothe people in our community. The only requirement to receive food & clothes is a picture ID of the head of the household in each family. Statistics gathered by Harvesters food bank show that 1 in every 7 people in Wyandotte county is food insecure (not having enough money to buy food). Many households have to choose between purchasing food and buying medicine. In the 7 years of STOREhouse, SPCC has provided the following: 6,841 households have been helped; 12,086 have attended STOREhouse sessions; 10,724 meals have been served (not including meals for volunteers); 9,519 have chosen clothes from our clothes pantry; and 23,935 have been provided food from the food pantry. God has worked in a mighty way through our congregation and community to 'Keep Jesus love by giving it away'. Thank you to everyone for your prayers, money, time, food, clothes and for all the thoughtful things you do and say to continue this ministry. Everyone is invited to come & observe and/or help at any of our sessions. We can use help between the hours of 10am-1pm every Tuesday to stock shelves with food on STOREhouse weeks or sort and hang clothes on the off weeks. The Wednesday sessions can use help anytime between 4:30-8:30 pm on STOREhouse nights. 2Corinthians 8:7 says, "But just as you excel in everything—in faith, in speech, in knowledge, in complete earnestness and in your love for us- see that you excel in this grace of giving."
